# How to Talk with Jesus

Pope Francis teaches children to talk with God this way: "Pick up the Gospel, a short passage, imagine what is happening, and talk to Jesus about it."

We follow this process every day in other areas of our lives. Think about it:

- 1.We wake up and grab our phone or sit down at the computer.
- 2. We read an article, a blog post, or a Facebook update.
- 3. The baby/kids/dog wakes up and off we go to do all the things.
- 4. As we're doing all the things, our mind keeps going back to what we read.
- 5. And then the conversation begins.

This week start out each day talking with Jesus. Do the process above: pick out a scripture, use your imagination (what did this mean back then? What does this mean for today? Why is God telling me this story right now?), and begin talking with Jesus about it. Pour out your questions, your hopes, and your dreams. Then, keep watching and listening throughout the day. Jesus may just speak back to you in a fresh, clear, new way. Here are some vivid scriptures from various parts of the Bible to explore: Mark 10:13-16, 2 Sam 12:1-4, Lk 15:8-10, Mt 21:28-31, Lk 10:30-35, Gen 11.1-9, Mt.8.23-27.
